BRYSON ISD PROCEDURES FOR LATE START, SCHOOL CLOSURE, OR EMERGENCIES - - GET NOTIFIED!!!

It can be a difficult decision when dealing with inclement weather conditions or other emergency situations that may arise. We will make weather related decisions as early as possible, but in many cases that may be early the day in question. Roads will be assessed between 5am-6am. It is possible that we will make the decision the day or evening before depending on the information that we have at our disposal. Each situation will stand alone and be dealt with accordingly. If BISD has school at regular time or has a late start during a weather event involving frozen precipitation, any student absence will be excuse for that day. If we are having school, we would love to have each BISD child in attendance, but in those cases that involve possible frozen precipitation, please use your own judgment. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding in dealing with this issue when it presents itself.
